## TURLOCK POLICE DEPARTMENT CRITICISMS / COMPLAINTS

Turlock Police Department believes a relationship of confidence and trust with the public is essential to effective law enforcement. Officers must be free to exercise their best judgment and to initiate law enforcement in a reasonable, lawful, and impartial manner without fear of reprisal. So, too, enforcers of the law have a special obligation to respect meticulously the rights of all persons.

Turlock Police Department acknowledges its responsibility to establish a system of complaint and disciplinary procedures that will subject officers to corrective action when they conduct themselves improperly.

To this end, Turlock Police Department welcomes from citizens of the community, constructive criticism of the Police Department and valid complaints against its members and procedures.

Any citizen who feels he or she has been a victim of misconduct by a member of the Police Department may file a "Citizen Report" which must be made within 60 days of the date of occurrence of the incident to any member of the Police Department. Complaints that involve major violations, as defined in policy, will be accepted at any time. Complaints of misconduct will be accepted and recorded on a "Citizen Report" form available at the Turlock Police Department, 244 N Broadway; or the City Clerk's Office, 156 South Broadway (City Hall). A copy will be given to you.

The person receiving the complaint will ask you to provide as much information as possible. The complaint will then be investigated in a timely, professional manner. The investigation consists of taking formal statements from all persons concerned and the gathering and preservation of any physical evidence or other information related to the incident. Each allegation is examined on its own merits in an objective manner.

The employee's Division Manager will examine the investigation and make a recommendation to the Chief of Police

**Further information**: Generally, complaints will not be accepted from persons who are intoxicated or under the influence.
