SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Calls for service kept officers busy through a majority of tonight's shift. We investigated three domestic battery incidents. In one of those cases, a woman was arrested. In the other two, the responsible men were gone upon police arrival and prosecution will be sought. Officers also investigated an unattended death in the 300 block of Wayside

Drive. No signs of foul play were found, and the county coroner's office responded to assist in the investigation. Meanwhile, we also investigated an allegation of physical child abuse where the offender was identified but not yet found. Later in the night, an officer tried to stop a man on a bicycle for several vehicle code violations in the 700 block of Spruce Street. That man initially did not stop and then struggled with the officer. The man was eventually detained with the help of a police K9 and arrested.
