SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

An officer followed up with a case from last week after an additional crime was determined to have occurred. During the course of a DUI investigation of a 17 year-old, the officer noticed graffiti that had been sketched into the plastic back seat of the patrol vehicle after the juvenile had been released to an adult. The juvenile suspect had maneuvered the handcuffs to the front of his body and used the handcuffs to carve into the plastic backing in the back seat, causing approximately \$1500 in damage. The juvenile was arrested at school and booked into juvenile hall for felony vandalism.
