### SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Swing shift was very busy and officers were going call to call up until night shift came on. Seven arrests were made between the two shifts. One arrest involved an Organized Retail Theft (O.R.T.) crew who hit Home Depot just after 5:00 p.m. With the help of LPR's, officers were alerted they had been in our area but they had already fled. The vehicle they were driving was located in Riverbank, several hours later, and all three suspects were detained by Stanislaus County Deputies. With this information, officers were able to determine the crew committed a theft at the Turlock Home Depot, taking approximately \$3,000 in

merchandise. All three were booked for O.R.T., conspiracy and grand theft. All felonies.
