SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

An officer investigated a late reported domestic violence call between husband and wife. The wife reported her husband had grabbed her by the arm during an earlier altercation while he was intoxicated. The husband was contacted and arrested. He was served with an emergency protective order and taken to jail. Officers responded to a

gas station for a report of male juveniles outside the store challenging people to fight. When officers arrived the group started to walk away from officers, but they were eventually contacted and detained. The juveniles were intoxicated, and one of them attempted to run from officers while handcuffed. The parents were called to pick them up, but the male who tried to run, also tried to drive away in his parent's vehicle when they came to get him. Officers removed the keys from the ignition, and the juvenile responded by throwing an object at an officer and attempting to punch and kick at officers, while shouting gang-related phrases. He was arrested and booked into juvenile hall.

SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

During this shift, officers made several arrests for a varying range of crimes. An officer was driving down a residential street in the south side of Turlock, and he noticed a subject who had a warrant. The subject was contacted and arrested after the warrant was confirmed. Later in the shift, an officer spotted a vehicle run a stop sign. The officer attempted a traffic stop, but the subject continued to drive, still running several stop signs. He eventually stopped and officers arrested him for DWI, as well as reckless driving. Officers also responded to a residence on the south side. TPD received a call from a female stating she was at her friend's house to avoid being around her husband. The husband located her and kept knocking on the front door, demanding entry. When officers arrived, the husband was contacted and detained. He was intoxicated, and was arrested for such. We confirmed there was not domestic violence that occurred, as the wife refused to open the door and speak to him in person.
