### SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Officers started the shift out by responding to the reports of someone trying to hit another with a metal pole. When officers arrived on scene and located a female they determined it to be a domestic dispute. The male half was located and refused officers commands to stop. The male had an aggressive dog with him and was using the dog to try and prevent officers from approaching him. Through de-escalation techniques officers were able to convince the suspect to tie his dog to a fence. The male was taken into custody after a brief struggle. He was arrested for obstructing and resisting. Through witness statements and video footage it was determined that the female had been attempting to hit the male with the metal pipe. She was arrested for assault with a deadly weapon. Both were booked into jail.

An officer investigated a shoplift at Target for \$120 worth of items stolen. The female suspect was arrested, cited and released. Officers responded to a traffic collision and determined one of the drivers had two felony warrants out of Tuolumne County. She was arrested, medically cleared at the hospital, and then booked in jail.

SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Several drunk drivers were arrested last night. An officer saw a vehicle doing burnouts in a gas station parking lot and made a traffic stop. The showed signs of intoxication and did poor on SFSTs. He was arrested for DUI and reckless driving. His BAC was .14%. While investigating a hit & run accident, officers were able to locate the suspect vehicle using LPRs, approximately 30 minutes after the collision. The vehicle was stopped and the driver was determined to be under 21 years old and had a BAC of .20%. He was arrested and booked. Another officer stopped a vehicle for driving south in the northbound lanes of a roadway. The driver was determined to be under the influence of alcohol and was arrested. He had a BAC of .20%. Lastly, a fourth DUI driver was stopped after he was seen swerving all over the roadway. He was arrested and had a BAC of .19%.
