SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Good shift throughout the night. Officers stopped a vehicle for observed violations. During the contact a DUI investigation was conducted which resulted in the driver being arrested. In addition to the DUI charges, a loaded firearm was located inside of the driver's area of the vehicle. He was booked into jail for DUI and weapons charges. Officers responded to a vehicle stopped in the road. The driver was non-responsive and upon making contact, a DUI investigation was conducted. This resulted in the driver being arrested for DUI related charges and booked into jail. Officers responded to a domestic disturbance where a male was outside and under the influence of both narcotics and alcohol. Due to his level of intoxication he was unable to care for himself in public and booked into jail.
