SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

It was an uneventful Friday night, with the exception of a vehicle pursuit that occurred. A male driver ran a red light in front of an officer. When the officer initiated a traffic stop the driver accelerated, attempting to evade the officer. The pursuit lasted about one minute and was about one mile in distance, before the driver took a turn at too high of a speed and the vehicle spun out and collided into a curb, disabling it. The driver and two passengers were detained. The driver was determined to be DWI and was found in possession of Cocaine. He was arrested and booked on several charges, and the passengers were released after statements were obtained.
