It was a slow night with calls for service. One traffic stop was the highlight of the shift. An officer saw a vehicle run two red lights and made a traffic stop on the driver. The driver displayed signs of alcohol consumption and admitted to consuming drinks earlier in the night. He showed a poor performance in the SFSTs and was eventually arrested for DUI.
