SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Officers responded to a residence two times for the report of a male banging on the RP's window. The male was reportedly the PR's ex-boyfriend, who was refusing to leave. The first time we responded the male was gone before we arrived and he was not located. The second call came about 20 minutes later. The male had come back and continued to bang on the RP's window again, when officers arrived they located the male in the front yard. He was heavily under the influence of narcotics and alcohol. He was arrested and booked for being under the influence in public. An officer made a traffic stop and found the driver had two active warrants/ He was arrested for the warrants, and when he was asked if there was anything illegal in the ca, he told officers there were drugs, and told the officer where the drugs were at. A search of the vehicle revealed close to 30 grams of Meth inside. He was arrested and booked for drug sales, along with his two warrants.
