Another steady swing shift with several in-progress calls. Several fights and disturbances kept officers busy. A domestic fight took place on Golden State near Fulkerth Rd where the male was arrested and booked. The victim disclosed several prior events of domestic

violence which were investigated and charged. FTO Young attempted to stop two juveniles on e-motorcycles and they decided to flee. A pursuit resulted and one juvenile was apprehended after he had a minor non-injury collision with a parked vehicle. The other juvenile was identified although not apprehended. The arrested juvenile was cited out on felony evasion to his mother.

SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Busy shift for nights. Officers made two arrests during separate contacts for warrants and the subjects were issued citations. Officers contacted a subject who was found to be in possession of narcotics and issued a citation. Officers made a traffic offense arrest for driving on a suspended license and the subject was issued a citation. Officers stopped a vehicle and initiated a DUI investigation which resulted in the driver being arrested for DUI related charges. Officers investigated two separate domestic violence incidents.
