### **SUPERVISOR COMMENTS**

The shift was steady with calls for service throughout the night. An Officer investigated a sexual assault against a juvenile who disclosed the assault happened in the City of Turlock while at a hospital in another county. The Officer worked with that agency in taking the proper report and collecting the proper evidence. A juvenile was riding his bike in darkness in an intersection when he was struck by a vehicle. A witness saw the vehicle drive away. It was determined that the driver was unaware she had hit a bicyclist. The juvenile sustained

minor injuries. Another Officer investigated a battery which occurred at the Vista Apartments. One party had thrown a cup of alcohol which likely contained pepper spray at another person. Following that incident, a friend of the victim then assaulted another person associated with the suspect who had thrown the cup's contents on the original victim. That investigation is on-going. Officers continued helping the graveyard shift with calls later into the night. Officers utilized the remaining time on their shift to work on reports.
