### SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Dayshift was busy all day. It started out with a found runaway from a group home in Merced. The juvenile was found sleeping on a sidewalk. He was turned over to group home staff after waiting two hours for them to pick him up. Soon after that, officer responded to a group home in Turlock for a report of a juvenile assaulting a staff. The juvenile was arrested and booked in Juvenile Hall. Officers responded to a domestic violence call and determined the suspect had been continually stalking his ex-wife and threatening her for the past few days. He broke into her home a couple days ago and assaulted her. Today, he returned and was waiting outside her home for her when he was met with TPD officers. He was promptly arrested and booked for burglary, felony domestic battery, stalking and criminal threats. Officers located an occupied stolen vehicle at Monte Vista Crossings this afternoon. The male driver was arrested and booked for vehicle theft and his female passenger was arrested/booked for several outstanding warrant, along with providing false identification to a peace officer.
