### SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

The shift began with a domestic violence call where a male assaulted his girlfriend with a hammer and threatened to kill her. He was arrested for domestic battery, assault with a deadly weapon, criminal threats, and also possession of an assault weapon, after officers located his AR15 assault rifle. An emergency protective order was sought and authorized by a judge for the victim. This afternoon, officers investigated another domestic dispute. This time, the suspect was a 16 year old female who assaulted her grandfather. She threw a full can of soda at him hitting him in the head. She was booked in Juvenile Hall for elder abuse and assault with a deadly weapon. Officers responded to another domestic dispute between an adult sister and her adult brothers. They had conflicting stories and no arrest were made. Officers responded to an adult male having a mental breakdown in his mother's home, breaking windows. He was located and detained for a mental health evaluation.
