The subject's family hadn't seen or heard him for about 2 to 3 days. When they could not reach him, they called TPD to assist. We met them at the subject's residence and we were allowed in. we found the door to his bedroom

closed, with the TV volume very high. When we entered the bedroom, the subject was found with a self-inflicted gunshot wound to his head. Per the family, he was having depression, thoughts of suicide, was going through a child custody battle, and was taking opiates for sever back pain. It appeared he took his own life 2 or 3 days ago.
