3. BUDGET WORKSHOP

A. The City Council will review, discuss, and provide direction regarding the Fiscal Year 2020-21 General Fund and Non-General Fund Budgets.

City Manager Toby Wells introduced this item, provided an overview of the budget process to date, and spoke regarding the status of the previous Fiscal Year budget, vacant positions, and the latest sales tax projections due to COVID-19. City Manager Wells asked for guidance from Council in preparation of the draft City budget.

Accountant, Sr. Nadine Silva presented information to Council regarding Fiscal Year 2019-20 and Fiscal Year 2020-21 budgets, including a draft summary of revenues and expenses, sources of General Fund revenue, projected revenues and expenses for Fiscal Year 2020-21, and the projected increase for PERS for Fiscal Year 2020-21. General Fund Department expenditures were highlighted for the Police Department, Fire Department, and other non-public safety departments. City staffing levels and vacancies for the previous two years were reviewed and an analysis of the General Fund reserve was presented.

Council and staff discussed this item, including the balance of the Fiscal Year 2019-20 General Fund reserve, compensated absences, the General Fund tax sources and projected revenues, sales tax revenue timelines, and COVID-19 sales tax revenue impacts.

Mayor Bublak opened public participation.

Council and staff further discussed this item, including the budget adoption schedule and options for addressing the Fiscal Year 2020-21 projected deficit.

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Council directed staff to proceed with the budget adoption schedule as proposed by the City Manager and authorized consideration to utilize potential General Fund savings (revenues over expenses) from the Fiscal Year 2019-20 budget.
